MOBY MAX GUIDELINES

- *Students will typically complete one assignment per week on Moby Max. They will usually be assigned on Tuesdays. Each week that assignments are due, they will be due by Monday at 11:59 p.m. (Don't wait until then ☺). We say 'midnight' because we want the kids to know that they have that day and after-school time to complete the work if needed.
- *Students will use their login information for their account as provided by their teacher. It is recommended that you save this in a secure place that will be accessible both at home and at school. (You don't want to be home for the weekend and realize you left your login information at school).
- *Students should be able to complete their assignment from any device (PC, Mac, Ipad, etc.) that has internet access.
- *The length of time required per week will vary from student-to-student. However, an average weekly time is around 25-45 minutes. If a student is having to spend more than 45 minutes per week on this, please talk to the teacher! Weekly assignments will basically be as follows:

***Math Lessons**- Complete 1 math lesson per week (Same rule as homework- Do not exceed 45 minutes. Talk to teacher if this happens!)

***Fact Fluency**- In the Math Lessons above students had to complete one lesson to fulfill their assignment. In Fact Master, their lesson is based on quality time spent practicing math facts. The length of time required will vary. The required minutes can be broken up throughout the week.

***Test Prep**- Test Prep is a module of Moby to help students prepare for standardized testing. Like Fact Master, students will be assigned a certain number of minutes to practice for each week that Test Prep is assigned.

- *The Moby Max assignment for the week will be discussed in the classroom on Tuesdays & posted to that day's homework calendar on the class webpage. Students will be given at least one day per week in advisory times to complete Moby work. Students can also work during team time on Moby assignments. Students should finish outside of school if they are not able to finish during school hours.

*Students should not complete more than 1 assignment per week unless arranged with the teacher.

*Students will receive weekly points for completion of that week's assignment & effort put into it. Teachers will use fair judgement in grading these assignments by examining the number of problems the student completed in the time assigned and accuracy.

*Since students have an entire week to complete Moby assignments **late credit is not available** unless there are extenuating circumstances.

*It is important for students to understand the procedure for when they get stuck on material while working in Moby:

a) Students can simply stop for the evening & ask for help the next day in class.

b) If the problem occurs on the last day before the due date, students can simply bring in a short note from a parent or ask a parent to send a short email indicating they tried to do the work but got stuck. We will provide help the next day and provide a short extension to finish.
